FOUR SIGNS THAT IT'S A SCAM!

1. SCAMMERS PRETEND TO BE FROM AN ORGANIZATION YOU KNOW



- Scammers often pretend to be contacting you on behalf of the government (FTC, Social Security, IRS, etc.)
- Some pretend to be from a business you know (utility company, tech company, or charity)
- They use technology to change the phone number that appears on your caller ID. So, the name and number you see calling MAY not be real

2. SCAMMERS SAY THERE'S A PROBLEM

- They might say you're in trouble with the government
- You owe money
- Someone in your family has an emergency
- Virus on your computer

or PRIZE

- You've won a sweepstakes or lottery
- A long-lost relative has passed away and left you money



The problem or prize can and do sound legitimate!



3. SCAMMERS PRESSURE YOU TO ACT IMMEDIATELY

- They want you to act before you think
- They might threaten to arrest you, sue you, take away your driver's license
- They might say your computer is about to be corrupted if you don't ACT NOW
- They will tell you to keep their conversation a secret or lie about funds
- They will give you "answers" to give your bank or law enforcement if you are questioned

This is the hardest time because they play on your fear and concern! Your heart may begin to race, or you feel scared or confused.

4. SCAMMERS TELL YOU TO PAY IN A SPECIFIC WAY

They often insist that you can only pay by using:

- Cryptocurrency
- Wiring Money
- Using a payment app
- Buying gift cards
- Getting cash out of your account
